SELF-ADVOCACY & COUNSELING ON ENROLLMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Join us for our summer Career Camp covering Self-Advocacy (8 hours) and Counseling on Enrollment Opportunities (12 hours) topics.

Participants will explore educational options in their career pathway, whether it be college, trade school, or straight into the workforce. Students learn to effectively communicate their strengths, abilities, interests and needs through self-advocacy training when interviewing with potential employers or applying to trade schools, colleges, or universities. This camp is designed for ages 16+.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Age 16-21
- Enrolled in high school or a postsecondary program
 - Has an IEP or 504 plan
- Diagnosis of a lifelong or acquired disability
- Utilizes a functional communication system
 - Clear desire to participate in the training
- Regulate his/her behavior with minimal directions
 - Students must attend every session
